

Novels:

1. **When the Ground Shakes Beneath** (2008, 200/-) is a modernist novel which is translated and published in Kannada, Gujarati, Panjabi and Hindi. Australian writer J.W. McMillan writes, 'Patil weaves the story of a young man and two sisters into an account of the disastrous earthquake in Gujarat in January 2001 and shows the many ramifications in the lives of those involved. It is a book to be read more than once!'
2. **A Don in the Jungle** (2008, 200/-) is a fictionalized political novel based on Veerappan's misdeeds.
3. **Under the Mango Tree** (2009, 200/-) is a farm novel reminding Markandaya's *Nectar in a Sieve* and Steinbeck's *The Grapes of Wrath*. This is translated into Kannada (Raita Kallappana Aatmahatye), Telugu () and Marathi (Phas!). These three novels may be studied as a 'Disaster Trilogy.'

Short Stories: Patil's short stories are published in journals and magazines.

4. **This is India and Other Stories** (2010, 100/-) consists of 17 stories.
5. **Scenes from Indian Life** (2012, 100/-) consists of 27 well narrated stories with experiment in narrative technique.
6. **Shalmala and Other Stories** (2015, 100/--9788192840338) is a book of short stories.

Travelogues: Patil is a serious traveler.

7. **In Shakespeare's England...** (2007, 4 eds; 200/- 978-81-928403-0-7) is a best-selling travelogue. The New Zealand writer Malcolm McKinnon writes: "In Dr. Patil's case, as a Professor of English literature, a visit to England was inevitably a journey into the literary as much as the real landscape of that country....Dr Patil's journey took him throughout England. He describes with great vividness Oxford University, where he had the opportunity to engage in study but also to explore...."

8. **Travels in the Himalayas** (2009, 2 eds; 100/-; 978-93-80213-00-2) is about the author's stay at IAS, Shimla as a Research Associate and about his visits to different places in the Himalayas.
9. **Travels in the North-Eastern States of India** (2001, 100/-) is an account covering Patil's visit to the North-Eastern states of India.
